Website Terms and Conditions

This page (together with the documents referred to on it) tells any person who accesses this site (“you”) the terms and conditions of use on which you may make use of our website www.airc.ie (“our site”). Please read these terms and conditions of use carefully before you start to use the site. By using our site, you indicate that you accept these terms and conditions of use and that you agree to abide by them.

If you do not agree to these terms and conditions of use, please refrain from using our site.

Information about us

Our site is operated by The Association of Irish Riding Clubs, a company incorporated in Ireland with company number 102514 whose registered office is at 1st Floor, Beech house, Millennium Park, Osberstown, Naas, Co. Kildare (“We” or “AIRC”).

Accessing our site

Access to our site is permitted on a temporary basis, and we reserve the right to withdraw or amend the service we provide on our site without notice. We will not be liable if for any reason our site is unavailable at any time or for any period. From time to time, we may restrict access to some parts of our site, or our entire site.

You are responsible for making all arrangements necessary for you to have access to our site. You are also responsible for ensuring that all persons who access our site through your internet connection are aware of these terms, and that they comply with them.

Prohibited Uses

You may use our site only for lawful purposes. You may not use our site:

- In any way that breaches any applicable local, national or international law or regulation.

National Event Entries

Customers may book their event entry for national events via the online booking using a credit or debit card.

Refunds (excluding the admin charge) will be issued for withdrawals received, in writing using the online event refund request form (F14/11), by the close of entries. Event entries are non-refundable and non-transferable after the closing date for refunds as outlined in the event schedule.

The customer must ensure all details of the entry are correct before finally purchasing their entries as no responsibility will be accepted for wrong entries that are the fault of the customer. If the customer experiences problems with the booking process, they are to contact National Office by email or by telephone.

The AIRC is not responsible if a customer enters a member into a wrong class or a class they are not eligible for.

In the event of the event being abandoned (i.e. after it started), for whatever reason, no refunds will be issued.
